Introduction


In these times when we are experiencing restrictions, isolation and impediments to leave our homes due to the pandemic, we continue our mission through virtual media. Thanks to these media, thousands of people are in contact with us, accompanying us and praying with us. To help us live more deeply our relationship with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, we present to you this triduum, which you can pray individually or in community.

In our preparation for the Solemnity of the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity we want to reflect and deepen some important elements of Communication from our Trinitarian Missionary Spirituality. The texts are taken from the Manual of Communication and Technology of the Missionary Servants of the Holy Spirit (pages 20 and 21).

The prayers are part of our congregational tradition and were composed by St. Arnold Janssen, except for the opening prayer, which is an appeal to the Holy Trinity to help us overcome the suffering caused by the pandemic and the political, socio-economic crisis that many of our countries in which we work and live our Mission are experiencing.

We wish each one of you a good preparation for the feast of the Holy Trinity and that, deepening in the meaning of the motto, "Long live God One and Triune in our hearts and in the hearts of all people", a legacy left to us by the founder St. Arnold Janssen, we can make it concrete through our gestures, words and actions.

FIRST DAY: GOD FATHER-MOTHER, CREATOR



We begin this first day of the triduum in preparation for the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity by becoming more aware of what it means to make the sign of the cross:

• In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.


Opening prayer

Reflection: FATHER-MOTHER GOD, CREATOR (SSpS Communication Manual, page 20)

"Beloved by the Father-Mother and created in the image and likeness of God, we are called to live in communion with the Holy Triune God, with each other as a community of consecrated women, with other people, and with all creation. The gift of communication helps us to grow in relationships and to participate in the continuous process of creation as caregivers of the Common Home, the universe of which we are a part. In this way, we expand our being, share our thoughts and receive experiences and knowledge of other people to improve our culture."



"Through the Incarnation of the Son in Jesus Christ, God communicated his greatest commitment to humanity. Communicating with human beings, speaking the same language and being understood, God becomes one of us - "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (Jn 1,14). Jesus, Divine Word, through the Incarnation, becomes the Father-Mother Communicator.

In the experience of his humanity, Jesus establishes a bridge of approach to God and reveals that God is a Father of loving, kind and compassionate Father. Jesus' passion for

the Father makes him the brother of all people, especially those who are most despised and deprived of their dignity. To reveal the love of the Father, Jesus heals the sick, gives sight to the blind, receives children and shares bread Jesus speaks in parables, in a language understandable to all, uses familiar images and symbols and gives himself in the Eucharist .

Jesus communicates who He is and gives Himself in the totality of His Love, giving his own life. Thus, Jesus becomes the model of each communicator. He personifies, in himself, the message of God and lives it to the end."

• In the name of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.





Reflection: GOD-SPIRIT OF COMMUNICATION (Text of the SSpS Communication Manual, page 21)

"The Holy Spirit is the central agent of communication between the Divine Persons, between human beings and between the Trinity and humanity and vice versa. The Spirit of love is the source of life that generates communion and makes all the evangelizing action of the Church a reality.

As Missionary Sisters Servants of the Holy Spirit, we are called to experience in depth the gift of communication as "fulfillment" of the mission of the Spirit in the world and in the Church. The Holy Spirit is the one who gives us Wisdom and Counsel to discern what to communicate and how. He gives us Understanding and Knowledge to reveal the meaning of situations and events, and their relationship to God's plan. He gives Compassion and

Fear of the Lord to open ourselves to the will of God in an attitude of deep respect for his presence manifested in people and in all creation. And finally, he gives Courage and Strength to remain faithful and consistent with the message that we receive and to profess it, with all its consequences".

To think and share

The present moment demands of us resilience and new attitudes in our being and acting missionaries.
